DERWA Announces New Authority Manager

DUBLIN – The Dublin San Ramon Services District · East Bay Municipal Utility District Recycled Water Authority (DERWA) Board of Directors announced the appointment of James Bewley as the new DERWA Authority Manager effective January 24, 2006. The DERWA Authority Manager is the Chief Executive Officer responsible for implementing the San Ramon Valley Recycled Water Program (SRVRWP). Bewley, stepping in as the first SRVRWP irrigation season is set to commence this spring, is replacing Robert Baker.

Bewley comes to DERWA with 35 years of wastewater treatment operations and management experience. He was previously the co-leader of the Redwood City/South Bayside System Authority recycled water project, now building a \$70,000,000 treatment, storage, and distribution system. Bewley is active in his community and his profession, including serving on numerous industry task forces and management boards.

DERWA Board of Directors President Frank Mellon said, “ The DERWA Board is confident Jim Bewley has the right skills and experience to oversee the program’s next phase – startup and operation. We look forward to a successful first year of bringing the community a drought-resistant water supply that conserves high-quality drinking water.”
