

SRVRWP Quick Facts

Purpose: to provide a drought-resistant recycled water supply for irrigation in the San Ramon Valley, while preserving drinking water and the environment

- A joint project of DSRSD & EBMUD since 1995
- Began delivering water in January 2006
- Currently providing over 4.0 million gallons per day to over 170 customer sites (*as of August 2007*)
- Designed to provide:
 - up to 3,696 acre feet per year (AFY) to DSRSD
 - up to 2,688 AFY to EBMUD
- Major facilities include:
 - 9.7 mgd treatment plant
 - 7 pump stations
 - 5 reservoirs
 - 70 miles of transmission & distribution pipelines
