Robert Baker to Lead Local Recycled Water Program

Dublin, Calif. – The **D**ublin San Ramon Services District – **E**ast Bay Municipal Utility District **R**ecycled **W**ater **A**uthority (DERWA) Board of Directors announced the appointment of Robert Baker as the DERWA Authority Manager effective December 9, 2002. The DERWA Authority Manager is the Chief Executive Officer responsible for implementing the San Ramon Valley Recycled Water Program. Baker will be responsible for planning, design, and construction of pipes and facilities that will deliver recycled water to parks, golf courses, greenbelts, and roadway landscaping in Dublin, San Ramon, Danville, and surrounding areas beginning in 2005.

Baker comes to DERWA with 30 years of engineering and water reclamation experience. He was previously the Engineering Department Manager at Central Contra Costa Sanitary District, where he managed infrastructure development and water reclamation operations. Baker received a B.A. and M.A. in Biological Sciences, as well as an M.S. in Civil Engineering with an Environmental Engineering Concentration, from San Jose State University. He is active in his community and his profession, including serving as Chair of numerous industry task forces and technical advisory committees.

DERWA Board of Directors President Richard Rose said, “The DERWA Board is confident that Bob Baker has the right skills and experience to get the first phase of the San Ramon Valley Recycled Water Program built. This program will help ensure use of recycled water where appropriate and reduce the risk of future drought rationing of potable water supplies.”
