Water recycler awards \$32M in construction contracts

Two East Bay construction companies and a Novato firm will begin work this winter on a recycled water project expected to be in operation by 2005.

DERWA is a partnership of the Dublin San Ramon Services District and the East Bay Municipal Utility District Recycled Water Authority. The partnership is building the plant to provide 5.7 million gallons of recycled water daily for parks, golf courses and greenbelts along the Interstate 680-580 corridor. The recycled water will be treated to standards making it safe for human use.

The authority has awarded an \$18.1 million contract to C. Overaa & Co. of Richmond for the tertiary treatment facility and pump station; \$9.7 to C.R. Fedrick Inc. of Novato for two storage tanks and \$3.9 million to McGuire and Hester of Oakland for transmission lines.
