Recycled Water Authority Receives New Member &  
Elects New Board Officers

The Board of Directors for the Dublin San Ramon Services District (DSRSD) (East Bay Municipal Utility District (EBMUD) Recycled Water Authority (DERWA) has a new Chair, Vice Chair, Director and alternate member. DERWA is the joint powers authority responsible for overseeing the implementation of the San Ramon Valley Recycled Water Program (SRVRWP).

The DERWA Board of Directors consists of two EBMUD and two DSRSD members including John Coleman and Frank Mellon from EBMUD, and Dan Scannell and Jeff Hansen from DSRSD. Director Hansen, who was an original member of the DERWA Board, rejoins the DERWA Board as a replacement for Richard Rose from DSRSD. Lesa McIntosh is the new EBMUD alternate, replacing Katy Foulkes. In early 2004, DERWA Directors elected Scannell as Chair and Mellon as Vice Chair of the DERWA Board.

"After six years of collaboration, construction of the project is now underway and we appreciate the efforts of everyone who assisted in getting DERWA to this point," says Dan Scannell, new DERWA Chair and DSRSD President. "This new board is eager to guide the project to completion and to deliver a drought-reliable water supply."

The board will continue to oversee the construction of this multi-phased recycled water program designed to provide landscape irrigation to the San Ramon Valley. The first phase of construction began in March 2004 and will continue through next year when the first recycled water delivery is expected in spring 2005.
